# Field Trip 4

## "EXPLORING THE GREY MATTER WONDERS"

**GRADE: : 9**

**VENUE: BRAIN MUSEUM (NIMHANS)**

### EVENT BRIEF:

The Grade 9 students, embarked on an enriching and eye-opening field trip to the Human Brain Museum at NIMHANS, Bengaluru, a one of kind facility dedicated to neuroscience education. The museum, housed within the Neurobiology Research Centre at NIMHANS, features over 400 preserved human and animal brain specimens. Students were welcomed by the museum's expert staff and began their visit with an introductory session on the structure and functioning of the human brain, led by faculty from the Neuropathology Department. This session helped them connect their classroom biology lessons to real-world anatomical understanding. The guided tour included an interactive component where students were given the rare opportunity to touch and hold a real human brain, a highlight that left many amazed and deeply reflective.

Inside the museum, students explored specimens showcasing the incredible diversity and complexity of the brain. Displays included normal brain structures, as well as brains affected by conditions such as Parkinson's disease, Alzheimer's disease, cerebral palsy, and various neuro-infections. The team also viewed accident injured brains, which helped reinforce the importance of road safety and wearing helmets.
